



OCTOBER 2014 REPORT

During the month of October 2014, the Indian Hills Police Department responded to 114 calls for service in Indian Hills, 8 in Rolling Fields, 5 in Mockingbird Valley, 4 in other areas, and performed 2,315 house and business checks.

The following criminal reports were filed...

- 10/23/2014 – Stonebridge Rd – Theft ***Cleared – Prosecution Declined***

Status updates on previous cases...

- 09/11/2014 – Matthew Clark pled guilty to Burglary 3rd Degree for his involvement in two 2013 burglaries on Poplar Hill Road and Mockingbird Valley Road. He was sentenced to 5 years in prison, diverted for 5 years and \$5,000 in restitution.
- 09/17/2014 – John Terry pled guilty to Receiving Stolen Property (Firearm) and Receiving Stolen Property Under \$10,000 for his involvement in two 2013 burglaries on Pueblo Road and Navajo Road. He was sentenced to 5 years, consecutive with LMPD charges (7 years in prison) and \$3,205 restitution.
- 10/09/2014 – Randall Rogers was indicted for a 2014 theft from Lightfoot Road.
- 10/09/2014 – Nathan Carey and Robert Thompson entered guilty pleas for their involvement in burglaries on Navajo Road and Jarvis Lane in 2014. Their sentencing is scheduled for November.
- 10/17/2014 – Jonathan Hensley pled guilty to 12 counts of Burglary, Receiving Stolen Property, and Persistent Felony Offender I, and was sentenced to ten years in prison. These charges include crimes committed in several jurisdictions. Part of his plea agreement included the forfeiture of his 2003 Mercedes E500 to the Indian Hills Police Department (to be used or disposed of for the benefit of the Department).
